Why SWJTU

Founded in 1896, Southwest Jiaotong University (SWJTU) is one of the earliest universities in China, and is known as "the Cradle for the Chinese Railway Engineers" and "East Cornell". Nowadays, SWJTU has developed into a multiversity with a focus on engineering and with development of multi-disciplinary, covering engineering, science, management, economics, liberal arts, law, and other subject areas. Its three campuses presently are located in Chengdu, the provincial capital of Sichuan province and Emeishan, the city with UNESCO World Cultural & Natural Heritage.

SWJTU pays great attention to international cooperation and exchanges. At present, it has established cooperative links with 97 universities, research institutes and enterprises from 33 countries. Currently, on campus, there are around 800 international students from 57 countries. Southwest Jiaotong University welcomes international students from all over the world.

Chinese Language Learning & Culture Experiences Programs

Long-term Program (more than six months)

Each semester SWJTU provides various Chinese language courses and cultural courses for overseas students with any level of Chinese. The main courses include intensive reading, extensive reading, listening, speaking, writing, characters and so on. Students will be allocated to appropriate levels according to the results of test on arrival. Experienced teaching staff and small class size of 20 students ensure the most efficient teaching and learning.

Short- term Program (2 weeks to 4 weeks)

Open Time, Duration and Deadline

June to August (6 weeks), every year. The deadline is April 30th.

Fees

1. Register fee: 300 RMB/person
2. Administration Fee: 1000 RMB/person
3. Internship: 1000 RMB/person
4. Transportation: 1500 RMB/person for 6 weeks except weekends
5. Accommodation fee: 50 RMB/day/bed-room (with two bed-rooms or three bed-rooms on campus students' dormitory; exclude electricity and water fee)
6. Translation: 200 RMB/person (for the factory translation every day)
7. Insurance: 180 RMB/person

Note: Once the program starts, all fees are not refundable.
